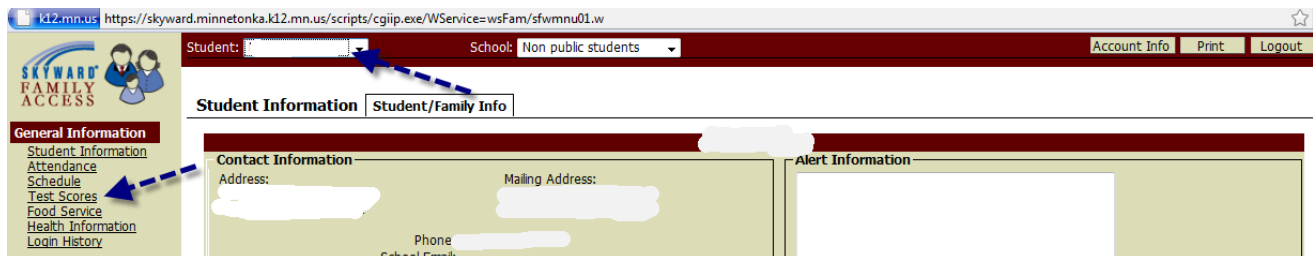
- **Skyward Family Access**

Skyward Family Access provides parents/guardians access to their child's/children's teachers and class schedule, attendance, food service activity, family contact information, grades, and report cards. The most important communications from school (grades, report cards, state test scores) rely on parents'/guardians' e-mail addresses in Skyward. Log in to Skyward to check or change your e-mail address. Click on Account Info to make changes. 4. Click on "show scores" next to GGG. This is the Get it, Got it, Go Assessment developed by the University of Minnesota. The assessment measures early literacy skills and includes alliteration, rhyming and picture naming fluency. We currently only use PNF-picture naming fluency. One of the best predictors of early literacy is how quickly and accurately children can name pictures of common objects, such as table, cat, and chair. There are national norms for fall, winter and spring and the goal is for each child to be at the 50th percentile or higher during each period. Your child's teacher will contact you if they have any concerns about any early childhood assessments.
